

Admission Policy

Siblings of currently enrolled students are given first priority. Children of Divine Child parish members receive first consideration for admission. Children of other Catholic parishes are considered next. Non-Catholic children may be admitted when there is space available, but only if their parents agree to their children's participation in the religious education program offered by Divine Child Elementary School.

Enrollment Application

Kindergarten applicants: To be considered for admittance to Divine Child Elementary School's kindergarten program, parents must first submit a Divine Child Enrollment Application, with copies of the student's birth certificate and baptismal certificate (if Catholic).

Grades 1 – 8: To be considered for admittance to Grade 1 – 8, parents must first submit Divine Child's Enrollment Application, with copies of the student's birth certificate and baptismal certificate (if Catholic). Parents must also submit a copy of their child's most recent report card and any standardized test scores.

Requirements

- Children entering Kindergarten in August must be 5 years old by September 1, 2017.
- Children entering 1st Grade in August must have completed an approved kindergarten program.
